PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 & A2, were apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for an alleged offences punishable under Section 407 of IPC, in Crime No.6 of 2014 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.According to the defacto complainant, he travelled in the bus from Bangalore to Nagercoil on 30.08.2013 and the accused who were working as Driver and Conductor has taken away the gold worth of Rs.1,85,000/- and cash Rs.1,00,000/- kept in the suit case.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the occurrence had taken place on 31.08.2013, but the complaint was lodged only on 03.01.2014. It is further submitted that for the mistake committed by the defacto complainant, the petitioners cannot be made to suffer.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioners have no bad antecedents and the major part of the investigation was over.

5.Considering the nature of offence, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kovilpatti and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., for a period of one week and thereafter, as stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.



6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
