PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as 13th accused in Crime No. 1 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 403, 406, 408, 420, 468, 477(A), 120(b) IPC and r/w Section 34 IPC and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner got additional amount of Rs.13,000/- by way of cheating the government officials under Crops Insurance Scheme and the petitioner had colluded with the other accused by producing a false document caused a loss of Rs.35 lakhs to the Government.

3.The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has received the amount only after producing the valid documents to the government officials and the petitioner has got no previous case.

4. The learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the petitioner and other accused, by producing false documents in collusion with government officials, received the amount under Crops Insurance Scheme. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that totally there are 49 accused and 5 accused were arrested and enlarged on bail and 25 accused were granted anticipatory bail and others are absconding.



5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of the case and considering the fact that 5 accused have been arrested and enlarged on bail and 25 accused were granted anticipatory bail, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanathapuram, and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
