PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A6 and A12, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 120(b), 147, 294(b), 494, 498(A), 506(i) r/w 109 IPC in Crime No.11 of 2015 on the file of the respondent Police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.According to the prosecution, the marriage between the de facto complainant and with one Raja was solemnized in the year 2009. After the marriage, she was subjected to cruelty for demand of dowry and she has been driven from the matrimonial home in the year 2010. Thereafter, her husband married 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner. When the same was questioned, the petitioners have threatened her with dire consequences.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of

arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thuraiyur, Trichy District, and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 am until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
