PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

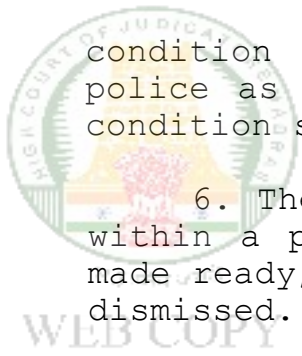
The petitioner, who is the sole accused, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Section 379 of I.P.C., in Crime No.525 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. According to the prosecution, that on 05.07.2015, the accused has taken away Rs.50,000/- from the co-passenger, while she was travelling in a bus.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is having two children, who are studying in Engineering Colleges and the present complaint is filed on 01.09.2015 for the occurrence said to have taken place on 05.07.2015 without proper explanation for inordinate delay.

4. Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side).

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of her arrest or on her appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Eraniyal, Kanyakumari District and on her executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further



condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
