PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 467, 468, 419 and 471 I.P.C. in Crime No.53 of 2014 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the second accused fraudulently sold the land of one Thavamani to an extent of 2 ½ cents to the petitioner, which was allotted to her, by the Government under the category of Adhi Dravida People.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the co-accused have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.21033 of 2014.

4. Heard the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondents.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court No.II, Sivagangai, and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when



required. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
