O R D E R

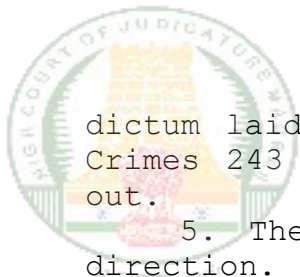

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has given a complaint to the respondent police as early as on 28.08.2015, but, however, the respondent police had not taken any steps to register a case and hence, the petitioner has come forward with this petition for the above stated relief.

3. At this juncture, the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side), on instructions, would submit that based on the two complaints given by the petitioner in Current Paper C.No.G7/3977/ 52313/15, petition enquiry is going on.
