PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A1, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act, in Crime No.749 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

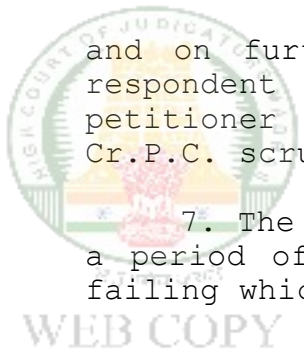
2.According to the de-facto complainant, on 23.08.2015 at 09.00 p.m., the accused after consuming liquor, developed quarrel with the de-facto complainant and caused damages to the bottles, chairs and tables worth about Rs.10,000/-.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that on 23.08.2015 the petitioner was attacked by the de-facto complainant and he was admitted in the Government Rajaji Hospital and on the next day, the complaint was given with an ulterior motive.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- to the credit of Crime No.749 of 2015 on the file of the learned Judicial No.V, Madurai



and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., for a period of two weeks. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
