PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as the accused, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 447, 294(b), 427, 379(NP), 323 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.322 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

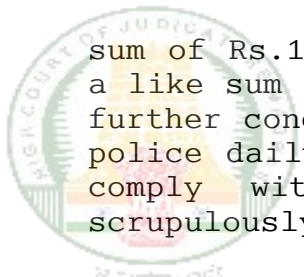
2.The case of the prosecution is that on 14.02.2015 the de-facto complainant gave a complaint before the respondent police against the petitioners alleging that the accused are jointly attacked the de-facto complainant and caused injuries.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the de-facto complainant is none other than the son-in-law of the first petitioner and on the date of occurrence, HE attacked the daughter of the first petitioner, when it was questioned a false complaint was given against them.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side)appearing for the State.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

<https://hcservices.courts.gov.in/hcservices> Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Nagercoil and on each of them executing a bond for a



sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
