O R D E R

The petitioner has come forward with this petition seeking for a direction, directing the respondents to register the FIR on the basis of the complaint of the Petitioner, dated 21.09.2015.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has given a complaint to the second respondent as early as on 21.09.2015, but, however, the second respondent police had not taken any steps to register a case and hence, the petitioner has come forward with this petition for the above stated relief.

3. At this juncture, the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side), on instructions, would submit that on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner, petition enquiry in Current Paper NO.G3/SP/2084/31177/15 is pending. He would further submit that the petitioner did not co-operate with the enquiry.

4. Considering the rival submission made on both sides, the petitioner is directed to co-operate with the enquiry and similarly, the second respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and follow the dictum laid down in *Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others* [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC) and register a case, if any cognizable offence is made out.

5. The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
