PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 and A2, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 498(A), 406 and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No.59 of 2014 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

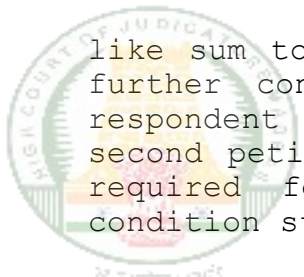
2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners demanded 25 sovereign of gold jewels and Rs.10 lakhs as additional dowry and also harassed her.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that due to matrimonial dispute, a false case has been foisted against the petitioners and it is further submitted that H.M.O.P.No.190 of 2014 filed by the first petitioner for divorce, is pending before the Sub-Court, Thirumangalam and the de-facto complainant filed maintenance case in M.C.No.240 of 2015 seeking maintenance. It is further submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail <https://hcmvts.courts.gov.in/hcmvts/> or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a



like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the first petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders and the second petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
