PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A2, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b) and 506(i) of I.P.C. in Crime No.267 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.According to the prosecution that the de-facto complainant is the District Secretary of Marxist Communist Party and on 23.09.2015 when he was conducted a public meeting, the accused came in an inebriated mood and quarrelled with the de-facto complainant.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that the petitioner is having two previous cases which are similar in nature.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on his bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Thoothukudi, and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall scrupulously.



7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
