PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who arrayed as sole accused apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 506(i) IPC in Crime No.314/2015 and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.According to the defacto complainant, when the defacto complainant was standing before his house, the Petitioner waylaid him and abused him in filthy language and assaulted him with stones and also threatened him with dire consequences.

3.The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that due to previous enmity regarding the temple festival, false complaint has been lodged against the Petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) submitted that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that injured had already been discharged from the hospital, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Andipatti, Theni District and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction to



the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m for a period of one week and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
