PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A8, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.424 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.According to the prosecution, due to previous enmity on 23.10.2015, the accused attacked the de-facto complainant and other persons and caused injuries.

3.It is represented by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the de-facto complainant party kidnapped one Nithiya for which, a case was registered against them. Since the petitioner, who assisted the de-facto complainant in that case to lodge the complaint against the de-facto complainant party, he has been falsely roped in this case and it is further submitted that even as per the complaint, the petitioner has not caused any injury on the victim.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that three persons sustained injuries in this case and they are taking treatment as in-patient and A1 to A4 have been secured.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Veda sandur, Dindigul District and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Veda sandur, Dindigul District, daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
