PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 to A3, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of TNWH Act, in Crime No.527 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

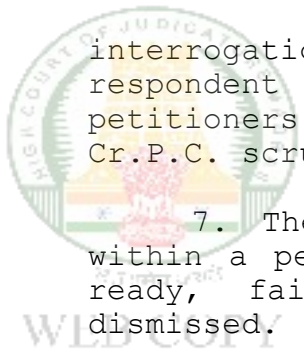
2.The case of the prosecution is that due to civil dispute between the petitioners and the de-facto complainant, the petitioners abused the de-facto complainant and threatened her with criminal intimidation.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that no one sustained injury in the alleged occurrence.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Usilampatti and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the second petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for



interrogation and the petitioners No.1 and 3 shall appear before the respondent police daily at 06.00 p.m., for a period of two weeks. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
