ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who arrayed as A2 and A3 apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), and 506(i) IPC and Section 4 of TNPHW Act and Section 4 of DP Act in Crime No.22/2014 and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

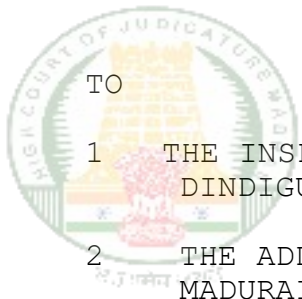

Hence this Court is of the opinion that the Petitioners are not entitled for the relief of anticipatory bail as sought for.
