PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

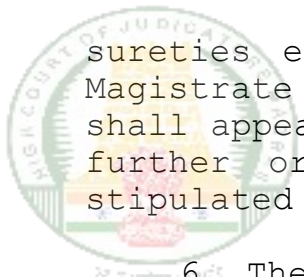
The petitioner, who arrayed as sole accused, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 341,506(ii) of IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Women Harassment Act in Crime No.702 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the due to earlier dispute between the petitioner and the de facto complainant, the petitioner waylaid the de facto complainant and tried to misbehave with her and also threatened her with dire consequences.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is an innocent and he has not committed any offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case and prays for anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner.

4. It is submitted by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) that the investigation of the case is pending.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate-II, Tuticorin and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two



sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
