PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

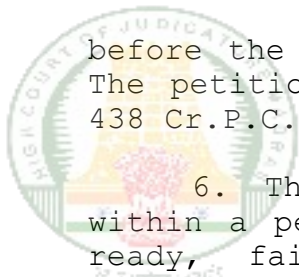
The petitioner, who is the sole accused, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 341,294(b),506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.797 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to civil dispute the petitioner has tried to attack the de facto complainant with deadly weapons and also threatened him with dire consequences.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that due to civil dispute a false complaint has been given against the petitioner. He further submitted that the petitioner is innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that the investigation of the case is pending.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that there is a civil dispute, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Karaikudi, Sivagangai District and on his executing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear



before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
