PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Section 294(b) IPC and Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Women Harassment Act, 2002, in Crime No.18 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. On a reading of the First Information Report, it is seen that this petitioner has taken photos of about seven named women, while they taking bath in the village pond.

3. Since the allegations against the petitioner are, indeed very serious in nature, this Court is not inclined to grant Anticipatory Bail to him. Hence, this petition is dismissed.
