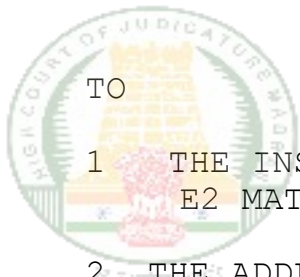
2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that on the basis of the complaint given by the *de-facto* complainant, petition enquiry has been conducted and closed.
