3.When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that the matter has been settled and the complaint has been closed.

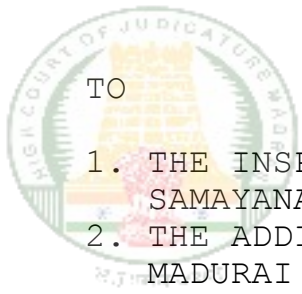
4.Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side), this criminal original petition is disposed of.
