PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police in Cr.No.71 of 2013 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 406 & 506(i) of IPC on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.This is the second anticipatory bail petition. The first petition for anticipatory bail was dismissed for default.

3.The Investigating Officer is present in Court.

4.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side).

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that in this case, investigation has been completed and final report has been filed on 29.08.2013 before the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Cheranmahadevi, in which the petitioner has been shown as absconding accused.

5.Considering the fact that investigation has been completed and charge-sheet has been filed, this Court is inclined to grant Anticipatory Bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Cheranmahadevi, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:



[a] the petitioner shall report before the concerned Court on all hearing dates.

[b] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[d] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
