3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) on instructions, submitted that the F.I.R. is registered in this case and she also seeks time to file final report.

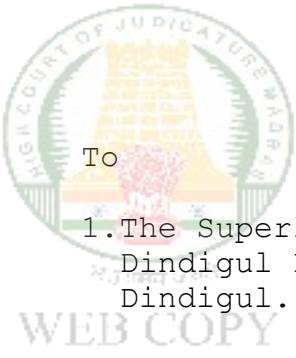
