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ORDER

The petitioners seek a direction to the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge(Protection of Civil Rights), Thanjavur to accept the surrender and consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on the same day in Crime No.67 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police.

2.The petitioners are accused for offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 427, 379, 506(ii) I.P.C r/w 3(i) (r) (s) and 3(2) (va) of SC/ST (POA) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014.

3.The submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent were heard. The materials available on record were also perused.

4.Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioners, the fact that anticipatory bail cannot be granted in respect of offences punishable under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and that taking into custody of the petitioners pending consideration of their bail application could cause them irreparable hardship, this Court considers it appropriate to direct the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge(Protection of Civil Rights), Thanjavur to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day and pass appropriate order on the same day of their surrender.



5.The petition is ordered accordingly.
