



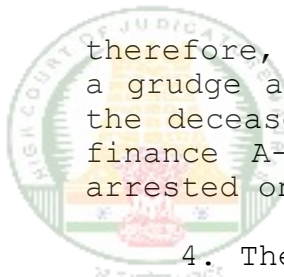

therefore, he had contacted A-1 to A-7 knowing that they were also having a grudge against the deceased and requested them to commit the murder of the deceased. In the confession of Murugan, he has stated that he would finance A-1 to A-7, if they do away with the deceased. Murugan was arrested on 26.02.2015.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that Arunprabu, who is the son of Murugan, and Nallakannu @ Kuthirai Nallakannu, who is the brother-in-law of Murugan, are being implicated for the first time through the confession statement of Murugan and, therefore, the police are setting up a case that is different from the case that was proffered by the *defacto* complainant. Therefore, this Court called for the case diary and perused the same.
