Considering the rival submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been unduly harassed by the respondent police to inform loss of jewelry lesser than that what actually lost as also the status report of the respondent police which informs of alteration of F.I.R pursuant to further information had from the petitioner and his daughter that as many as 73 sovereigns of gold was involved and that the entire gold of 73 sovereigns have been recovered pursuant to the arrest of several accused persons, this Court does not consider it appropriate to transfer the investigation. However, the jurisdictional Deputy Superintendent of Police, is directed to monitor the investigation.

4. The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
