Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying to direct the Learned III Additional Sessions Judge cum PCR Court, Madurai to accept the surrender of the petitioner herein before him in Crime No.44 of 2015 on the file of the second respondent police and consider the petitioner's bail application on the same day itself.

O R D E R

The petitioner seek for a direction to the Learned III Additional Sessions Judge cum PCR Court, Madurai to release the petitioner on bail, on the same day in the event of his surrender and filing bail application in Cr.No.44 of 2015 pending investigation on the file of the second respondent police.

2.The petitioner is accused for offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 420, 506(i) of I.P.C. and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Women Harassment Act and Section 3(1)(R)(S) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014.

3.The submissions made by Mr.R.Murugan, learned counsel for the petitioner and by Mr.K.V.Rajarajan, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) representing the respondents were heard. The materials available on record were also perused.



4.Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioner, the fact that anticipatory bail cannot be granted in respect of offences punishable under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act 2014, and that taking into custody of the petitioner's pending consideration of their bail application could cause him irreparable hardship, this Court considers it appropriate to direct the learned III Additional Sessions Judge cum PCR Court, Madurai, to consider the bail application of the petitioner on merits and pass appropriate order on the same day of his surrender.

5.The petition is ordered accordingly.
