It is the further submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner that none of 161(3) statements of witnesses in the case implicated the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) submits that owing to the abscondance of the petitioner, the case against him stands split up and numbered as S.C.No.87 of 2010 and non-bailable warrant is pending against the petitioner.

5.In view of the above, finding no merits, this Criminal original Petition shall stand dismissed.
