PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who were arrayed as accused apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under sections 294(B), 323 of IPC and section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, in Crime No.56 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

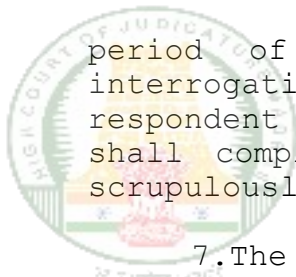
2.One Sakila has lodged a complaint before the respondent police alleging that on 27.03.2015, the petitioners harassed and also threatened her.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners innocent persons and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that it is a case of case and counter.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Nanguneri, Tirunelveli District and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the first petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for a



period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation and the petitioners 2 and 3 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
