Prayer: Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying to direct the Learned Principal District and Sessions Judge(PCR), Trichy, to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day on merits in the event of their surrender in connection with Crime No. 129 of 2015 on the file of the respondent.

O R D E R

The petitioners seek a direction to the Principal District and Sessions Judge(PCR), Trichy, to release the petitioners on bail, on the same day in the event of their surrender and filing bail application in Cr.No.129 of 2015 on the file of the respondent.

2.The petitioner is accused for offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 324, 506(ii) of IPC r/w Section 3(1)(r) and (S)3 (2)(Va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act,2014.

3.The submissions made by Mr.M.Selvendran learned counsel for the petitioners and by Mr.K.Anbarasan, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) representing the respondents were heard. The materials available on record were also perused.

4.Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioners, the fact that anticipatory bail cannot be granted in respect of offences punishable under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014, and that taking into custody of the petitioners pending



consideration of their bail application could cause them irreparable hardship, this Court considers it appropriate to direct the Principal District and Sessions Judge(PCR), Trichy to consider the bail application of the petitioners on merits and pass appropriate order on the same day of their surrender.

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5.The petition is ordered accordingly.
