PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A33 apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under sections 403, 406, 408, 420, 468, 477(A), 120(B) r/w section 34 of IPC, in Crime No.1 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

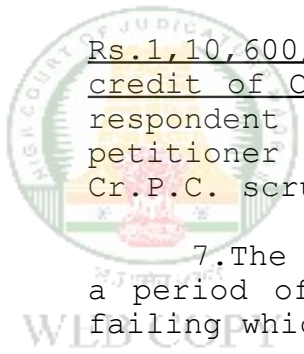
2.The case of the prosecution is that there was a Crop Insurance Scheme for the year 2009-2010 held by the Pookulam Primary Agriculture Co-operative Credit Society, in which the accused persons committed fraud and misappropriated a sum of Rs.35,78,205/-. The allegation against the petitioner is that by producing bogus certificate, he obtained Crop Insurance to the tune of Rs.1,10,600/-.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is a landlord and he has nothing to do with the alleged occurrence.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent and he has submitted that the investigation is almost over.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Ramanathapuram and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of



Rs.1,10,600/- [Rupees One Lakh ten thousand and Six hundred only] to the credit of Crime No.1 of 2015 and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
