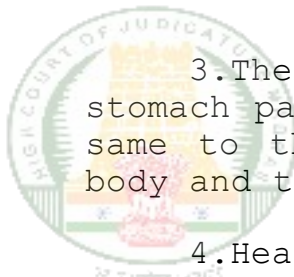

PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 to A18 apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 147, 176, 201 of IPC altered into 306 of IPC in Crime No.81 of 2015 on the file of the respondent Police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the daughter of the petitioners 1 and 2 namely, Iswariya committed suicide. However, the same to the Police they have cremated the body and the accused 3 to 18 and others helped the accused 1 and 2.



3.The learned for the petitioners submitted that due to the stomach pain the deceased committed suicide and after informing the same to the relatives of the petitioners, they have cremated the body and they have not committed any offence.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent Police.

(*)5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai, and on their executing a common bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10 am until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
