PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A1, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 447, 294(b) and 506(i) of I.P.C. in Crime No.365 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

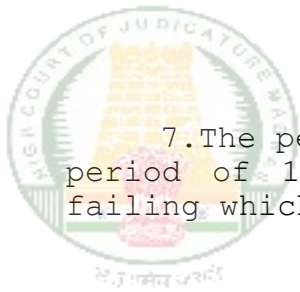
2.The case of the prosecution is that on 20.03.2015, when the defacto complainant was in his shop, the petitioner forcibly pulled him to quit the shop, by using filthy language and made life threatening on him.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and she has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side), who would submit that there is a civil dispute between parties.

5.Considering the submissions made by both sides, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on her appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, No.V, Trichy and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



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7.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
