PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 to A3 and A7 to A9, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 497, 294(b) and 336 I.P.C in Crime No.7 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the matter is settled and the defacto complainant and her husband are living together.

3. The Mediation Centre has also sent a report dated 22.04.2015 stating that the matter is amicably settled.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the State.

5. Considering the above aspects, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Muthukulathur, Ramanathapuram District, on each of them executing own bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.



7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
