2. Heard both sides.

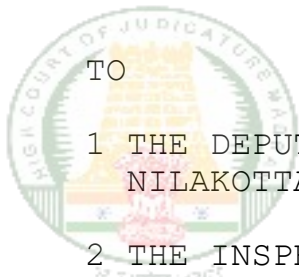
3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was taken by the respondents on 03.04.2015 and 15.04.2015 without any basis.
