PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

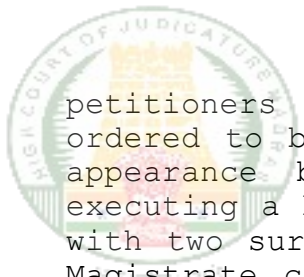
The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused Nos.1 to 8 apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 447, 448, 294(b), 364, 365 and 506(ii) of I.P.C. and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prevention of Sexual Harassment of Women's Act in Crime No.61 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the matter has been settled before the Mediation Centre and the report of the Mediation Centre also shows that the matter was amicably settled.

4. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the



petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Valliyoor and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
