The petitioners seek a direction to the learned III Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge for (PCR Act) cases, Madurai to consider the bail application of the petitioner / Accused in Crime No.182 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and consider their bail application on the same day of surrender on merits.

2.The petitioners are accused for offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 294(b), 506(ii) IPC r/w.3(1) (s) (r) & Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Act the New Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014.

3.The submissions made by Mr.M.Vijayagopal, learned counsel for the petitioners and by Mr.K.Anbarasan, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) representing the respondent were heard. The materials available on record were also perused.

4.Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioners, the fact that anticipatory bail cannot be granted in respect of offences punishable under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, and that taking into custody of the petitioners pending consideration of their bail application could cause them irreparable hardship, this Court considers it appropriate to direct the learned III Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge for (PCR Act) cases, Madurai to consider the bail application of the petitioners on merits and pass appropriate order on the same day of their surrender.



5.The petition is ordered accordingly.
