PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner is arrayed as A.3 in Crime No.185 of 2014 on the file of the respondent police, for the offence punishable under Sections 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(C) and 25 of NDPS Act. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 19.11.2014. He has come forward with this petition seeking bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in possession of 10 kgs of ganja.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was in judicial custody from 19.11.2014

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) would submit that there is no previous case as against the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the petitioner has been in judicial custody from 19.11.2014 and there is no previous case as against the petitioner, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District and Principal Special Judge for EC and NDPS Act cases, Madurai and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily twice at 10.00 a.m. and 05.00 p.m. until further orders.
