PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 498(A) and 506(i) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of Women Harassment Act and Section 4 of DP Act, in Crime No.22 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.According to the de-facto complainant, the accused harassed her demanding more dowry and also withhold her articles.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned counsel for the intervenor submitted that as per the order of this Court dated 27.07.2015, the accused have appeared before the respondent police and also returned the entire jewels and household articles and Rs.50,000/- cash, which are giving at the



time of marriage. He further submitted that the petitioner has filed a memo dated 27.07.2015 and signed by both sides for receipt of the articles and he has no serious objection for granting of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5. Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Usilampatti, Madurai District and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the first petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation and the petitioners No.2 and 3 shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

8. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
