PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A.3, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 341 and 506(i) I.P.C. in Crime No.153 of 2015, on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused picked up a quarrel with the defacto complainant and abused the defacto complainant.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) would submit that the victim had sustained only simple injury.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like



sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
