PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as an accused, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 341 and 506(ii) of I.P.C. in Crime No.34 of 20145 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that when the de-facto complainant was returning home, the petitioner along with others restrained the de-facto complainant with knife and abused him with filthy language and threatened with dire consequences.

3.It is submitted by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) that the no one sustained injury in the alleged occurrence.

4. Considering the facts and circumstance of the case and also considering the fact that no one sustained injury in the alleged occurrence, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aruppukottai and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for period of two weeks. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
