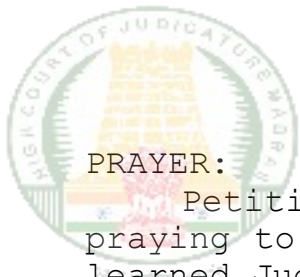

COMMON ORDER

These petitions have been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., praying to call for the records in C.C.Nos.71 and 72 of 2013 on the file of learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Madurai and quash the same.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the first respondent and the learned counsel appearing for the second respondent.

3.A perusal of the complaint would go to show that both the petitioners have given complaints against each other. Both the cases have been taken on file in C.C.Nos.71 and 72 of 2013 for the major offence punishable under Section 506(ii) I.P.C.

4.When this matter is taken up for hearing, both parties appeared before this Court along with their respective counsel and pursuant to the same, a memorandum of understanding, dated 16.04.2015 has been filed, entered into between the petitioners and the defacto complainant.
