PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A10, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 307 and 302 I.P.C., altered into 109, 120(b), 147, 148, 294(b), 307 and 302 IPC, in Crime No.28 of 2015, on the file of the respondent police hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence and a false case has been foisted against him. He has further submitted that the petitioner was already granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 20.04.2015, in Crl.O.P.(MD) No.6757 of 2015. But, due to threat, he could not execute the securities and appear before the respondent Police.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submits that investigation is almost over.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the petitioner has already been granted anticipatory bail, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

5.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Valliyur, and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before Kaliyakavilai Police Station, Kanyakumari District, daily twice at 10.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., until the petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
