PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b) and 506(i) I.P.C. in Crime No.122 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The allegation against the petitioner is that he threatened the defacto complainant with dire consequences.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is no way connected with the defacto complainant at any circumstance and prays for anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side)submitted that none sustained injury in this case.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.2, Trichy, and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



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6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
