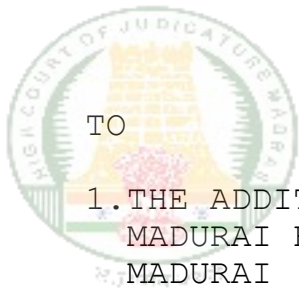
3.Recording, the submission of the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), these Petitions are dismissed.
