ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner/A4 apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 403, 406, 408, 420, 468, 477(A), 120(B) r/w 34 IPC, in Crime No.1 of 2015, on the file of the respondent and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.
