PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused No.1, in Crime No.29 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 307 I.P.C. and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to land dispute, the accused attacked the defacto complainant with wooden log.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent person and he has not committed any offence and pray for anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner. He would further submit that the alleged victim is also discharged from the hospital and the accused Nos.2 to 4 were granted anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court.

4.It is submitted by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) that due to civil dispute the accused had attacked the defacto complainant and the victim has been discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the injured person had already been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Mudhukulathur and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
