PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 to A3 apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under sections 147, 148, 294(b), 506(ii) and 379 (N.P) of IPC, in Crime No.464 of 2013 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused have abused and threatened the de-facto complainant and his workers and forcibly vacated them from the petition premises.



offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the first petitioner has elected as President of the Cooperative Society and the other petitioners are staffs of the society and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the case is registered in the year 2013 and after investigation, the respondent had laid a charge sheet in this case.

5.Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.2, Dindigul and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
