It is also stated by the revision petitioner that the balance amount of Rs.2,50,000/- will be paid to the respondent herein at the time of giving evidence before the Sub Court, Thirumangalam in H.M.O.P.No.478 of 2011. The wife admits that she has already received gold jewels, valuables and other household articles from the revision petitioner and she has no further claim whatsoever.

3.Thus, the Criminal Revision Case is disposed of in terms of the joint memo of compromise. The joint memo of compromise shall form part of this order. Consequently, connected M.P.is closed.
