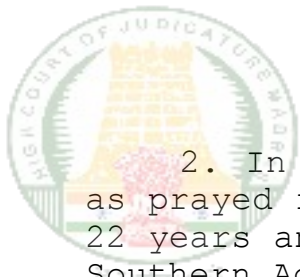

The petitioner is the father of the detenu. Today the detenu appeared before this Court in person along with R4-Mr.Prabhu. The petitioner also present in the open Court. The petitioner, Mr.Mathivanan identified the detenu in open Court. The detenu has asserted that she has married R4-Mr.Prabhu, in Kaliyamman Temple at Kumbakonam and later on registered the marriage on 06.07.2015 as per the details enclosed at page No.7 of the typeset. Further the detenu has categorically asserted in open Court that no one has illegally detained her or harassed her and she wants to go with R4-Mr.Prabhu. The petitioner also heard the statement made by the detenu in open Court.



2. In such circumstances, there is no scope to pass any order as prayed for in this Habeas Corpus Petition, as the detainee is aged 22 years and she has completed B.E. Degree and previously working in Southern Agro Engine Private Limited, at Chennai.
