3. The second respondent viz., the Inspector of Police, Taluk Police Station, Dindigul has produced the detenu and she has been identified by the petitioner.

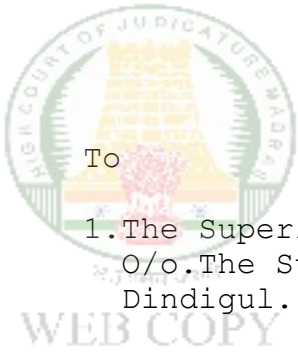
